FAQ

Academic Standards

Our programs and exhibits support the new Colorado Academic Standards for PreK-Grade 3 and Colorado's 21st Century Skills of self-direction, critical thinking, invention, collaboration and information literacy.

Ages

The Museum's exhibits are designed for children newborn through eight years old. Our programmed field trips are perfect for children PreK-Grade 2 and our outreach programs serve children PreK-Grade 3.

Booking a Program

Chaperones

Group chaperones are parents, teachers or caregivers over 18 years old. The Museum requires one chaperone for every five children attending. Adults in this 1:5 ratio are free of charge. Additional adults are welcome to join your field trip for the same price as students: \$6.50 for programmed field trips (\$7.00 for Just Toolin' Around) and \$4.50 for self-guided field trips.

Payment for all chaperones must be made collectively with your group payment or full adult admission (\$8) will be due upon arrival. Download a handy chaperone guide at www.mychildsmuseum.org/educators.

Lunch

We do not have indoor facilities for lunch or snack, even in the case of inclement weather. The Museum is located next to Gates Crescent Park where park benches and grassy areas are available on a first-come, first-served basis.

Minimum Group Size

A minimum of 10 children is required to qualify for discounted group rates. Group minimums for facilitated programs vary, please see program descriptions for details.

Payment

In order to qualify for our discounted group rates, you must pay for everyone in your group with a single collective payment. Payment is due one week prior to your visit or program and may be paid via check, credit card or cash. Please note that memberships cannot be used toward group visits.

Safety

Safety is the utmost priority at the Children's Museum of Denver. Should you need assistance during your visit, contact any staff member on the Museum floor. Basic first aid supplies are available at our front desk.

For the safety of all our guests, there are no adults allowed in the Museum without children, and no children allowed without adults.

Scholarships

The Children's Museum of Denver has scholarship funding available for programs, field trips and transportation reimbursement. Qualifying schools must have at least 50% of their students participating in the school's free/reduced lunch program. Certain limitations apply. Funding is based on availability. Siblings

Due to safety and supervision requirements, siblings are not permitted to accompany groups on field trips. Adults who are supervising other children/younger siblings do not count toward your 1:5 required ratio and must pay full admission.

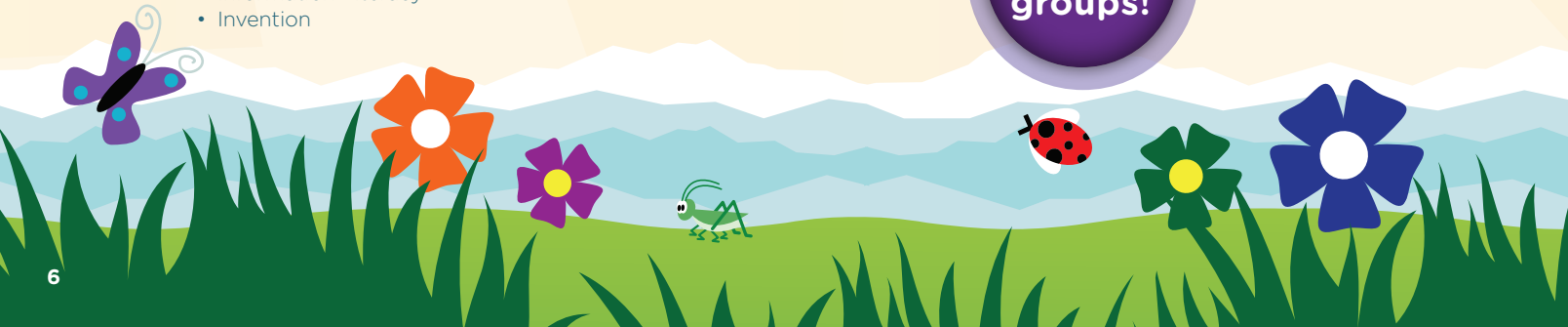
