Today: Kids Food Festival To-Go at Children's Museum of Denver at Marsico Campus

Denver, CO – The Creative Kitchen Kids Food Festival To-Go teaches families the importance of balanced food choices through their signature activity, the Balanced Plate Scavenger Hunt. The events aid in the prevention of childhood obesity through programming that's fun and educational, supporting the concept of learning through play. Ten children's museums, including Children's Museum of Manhattan, Portland Children's Museum, Chicago Children's Museum and Children's Discovery Museum of San Jose, participated in Kids Food Festival To-Go as a part of a four-month pilot campaign.
