matching gift programs

Many businesses have matching gifts programs, where donations made by staff members to non-profits are matched by their employer. Ask if your company has a matching gift program, allowing your support to go even further.

leave a legacy

Bequest

Ensure the future of the Children's Museum for generations to come by including the Museum in your estate plans. Speak with your attorney about adding a codicil or provision to your will.

Example language: "I hereby give, devise and bequeath to the Children's Museum of Denver, Inc. a non-profit corporation existing under the laws of the State of Colorado, the sum of \$_____ (or ___ percent of the rest, residue and remainder of my estate) to be used for the general purposes of the Museum (or for a particular program of your choosing)."

IRA Qualified Charitable Distribution

If you are 70½ or older, you can make a gift of up to \$100,000 per year directly from your IRA to the Museum without having to pay income taxes on the donation. This can also help to satisfy your required minimum distribution for the year. Contact your IRA custodian for more information or to make a gift.

Beneficiary Designations

An easy way to support the Museum's future is through beneficiary designations. List the Children's Museum of Denver, Inc. as a beneficiary of your IRA or life insurance policy.
