

Donation Request Guidelines

The Museum receives a high volume of requests for donated general admission passes. As a non-profit organization we are limited in the number of requests we can fulfill. We make every effort to work with organizations that are most closely aligned with our mission.

What types of organizations qualify?

- Organizations must be a non-profit 501(c)(3)
- Organizations that directly benefit children
- SCFD organizations
- Others to be evaluated on an individual basis

Who does not qualify?

- Organizations that discriminate based on race, religion (creed), color, ethnicity, national origin (ancestry), religion, sex, sexual orientation, gender expression, age, disability, veteran status, military obligations, and marital status.
- Labor or political organizations, and fraternal or membership organizations.
- Individuals (please note the following options for free or discounted Museum admission):
 - Joy Park Free Nights: Play in Joy Park for free the third Friday of the month, May September, from 4 pm until sunset.
 - Military: \$2 off per person
 - SNAP Access: \$3 admission per person for anyone receiving SNAP benefits. Guests show their EBT card at check-in. Valid for up to 10 eligible people per party. Event Day pricing may vary. SNAP cardholders also receive a 10% discount in the Café.

How do I request a donation?

- Please fill out the <u>Donation Request Form</u> and submit to <u>DonationRequests@cmdenver.org</u> 60 days prior to your event.
- Requests submitted within 60 days of an event will not be considered.
- NO FOLLOW-UP PHONE CALLS OR EMAILS, PLEASE.

When can I expect to hear from you?

• We mail out approved donations during the last week of the month.

What is a typical donation?

- We donate four (4) admission passes valued at \$72 to qualified organizations.
- We are not able to honor requests for donated memberships.
