Guests will enjoy ball drops on the hour, bubble wrap fireworks, fountains of confetti, crafts, appearances by special characters and more.

Ball drops on the hour from 10 am – 4 pm, immediately followed by Sparkly Science Experiments, featuring Museum educators in glittery lab coats creating exploding snow, levitating tinsel and more.

Other ongoing activities include face painting, sparkler and noisemaker crafts, Rocky Mountain Mini Train (\$2 per ride), music on the plaza with KBCO and meet & greets with the Klondike the Polar Bear and other surprise guests.
